

Run-off Election

Local Union 32, IBEW

A run-off election for the Business Manager Office of Local Union 32 shall take place on August 10, 2020 between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the local union meeting hall located at 1975 N. West Street, Lima Ohio 45801. The ballots will be counted immediately following the closing of the polls, and the results shall be announced immediately after all ballots are counted. A complete listing of the results shall be posted on the union bulletin board by the close of business on the day following the election.

Article III section (k) of Local Union Bylaws

"(k) In the event the candidate does not receive a majority of the votes cast for a specific office, then a run-off election will be held between the two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes. This does not include candidates for the Local Union Executive Board or Examining Board which shall be decided for the candidate receiving the most votes.

(1) When a run-off election is necessary, such run-off election shall be held twenty-one (21) days after the regular election is held."

Absentee ballots shall be available to any member upon written request to the IBEW Local Union 32 Election Board at P.O. Box 19, Wapakoneta, OH 45895. Such Requests will be accepted up to 5 days prior to the date of the election. No one receiving an absentee ballot will be entitled to vote at the polls without first presenting the election judge with the unused ballot. Absentee ballots received at the post office box after 11:00 a.m. on August 10, 2020, will not be counted. As per Article III Section (e) *"No member receiving an absentee ballot shall be permitted to vote in person at the election, unless he/she has first returned the absentee ballot unmarked to the Election Judge."* Members who requested an absentee ballot for the regular election will automatically receive same for run-off.

The same rules shall apply to the run-off election as were applicable to the regular election. All officers shall be installed and begin their 3 - year terms at the regular meeting of the Local Union on August 17, 2020.
