Season’s Greetings from your Training Center!

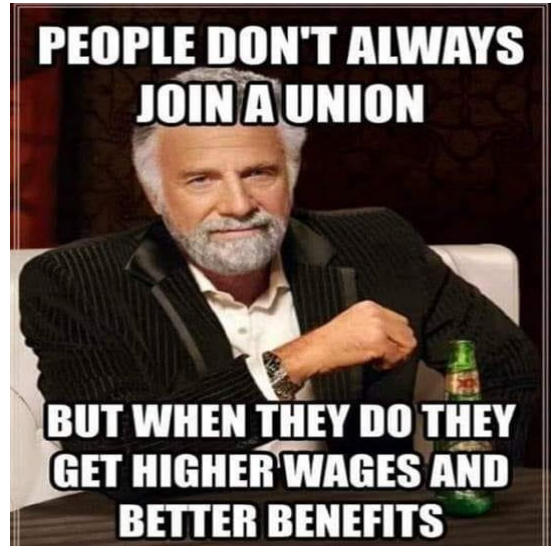
