Training Director's Report

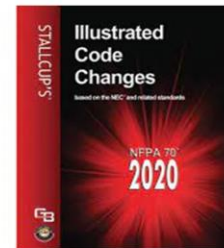
I would like to send a warm welcome out to all the 8 new Apprentices who will start in September. Please extend a welcome and helping hand to all.
