Cranes and Digger Derrick Awareness – 11 Lessons with included quizzes, approx. 2-3 hrs

\$100.00 Participation Award upon full completion.

Emotional Intelligence – 8 Lessons with included quizzes, approx. 2 hrs

\$100.00 Participation Award upon full completion

Human Performance – 6 Lessons with included quizzes, approx.. 1.5 hrs

OSHA 30 is delivered through Click Safety and all other classes and lessons will be delivered through the online LMS system used by the apprenticeship.
