ELECTION JUDGE & TELLERS NEEDED



IBEW Constitution—Article XVI, Section 11, as amended states: “The L.U. shall decide the manner in which the nominations and elections shall be held, and such shall be stated in the L.U. Bylaws. There shall be one (1) judge, who shall be selected by the method stated in the L.U. bylaws, and who shall be selected a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to the date on which the L.U. sends its notice of nominations and elections. There shall be as many tellers as necessary, who shall be selected by the method stated in the L.U. Bylaws. The election judges and tellers must have been members in continuous good standing for at least two(2) years immediately prior to the election, provided the L.U. has been in existence for this length of time. Election observers must be members eligible to vote in the election.

L.U. 32 Bylaws—Article III Sec. 4. (a) At the meeting of the Local Union when nominations are made, after nominations have closed, the President shall appoint an Election Judge and as many Tellers as are required, who shall serve as an Election Board to conduct the election. No candidate for any office shall be eligible to serve on this Board.

All judges will receive appropriate IBEW training prior to the election.
